

ANNEXURE-VI

The Estimates Committee of the fourth Lok Sabha (1967-68) emphasized the need for intensive research to provide a scientific basis for development of trout and other hill fisheries. The committee further suggested that vigorous attempts be made by the Central Inland Fisheries Research Institute (CIFRI), Barrackpore, Kolkata for the development of trout and other high altitude fisheries in hilly areas of Uttar Pradesh, Karnataka, Kerala and Tamilnadu. Subsequent review of research programmes of the CIFRI by the achievement audit committees in 1972, 1978 and quinquennial review team in 1983 repeatedly stressed the urgent need to intensify research on coldwater fisheries by creating infrastructure and providing additional scientific, technical and other support staff. During mid-term appraisal of the VI plan the ICAR decided for intensification and strengthening of coldwater fisheries research. In spite of various recommendations made by different committees, the coldwater fisheries research under the aegis of CIFRI remained limited due to lack of infrastructure facilities. Even the manpower support for coldwater fisheries remained same since third five-year plan period. Subsequently the working group on Agriculture Research and Education for the VII plan suggested that research in this area be strengthened by having a separate National Research Centre (NRC). It was in 1987 that the National Research Centre on Coldwater Fisheries (NRCCWF) was born as an independent centre directly under ICAR control with its temporary headquarters at Haldwani in erstwhile Uttar Pradesh. Subsequently, from May 1997 this temporary headquarters of the institute was shifted to Bhimtal about 30 km from Haldwani, where the main complex of NRCCWF was constructed.

Keeping in view the ever expanding activities of NRCCWF and the greater potential of coldwater fisheries in different Himalayan states, in a significant decision during the XI plan, it has been made a Directorate of Coldwater Fisheries Research (DCFR), to develop location, situation and system specific technologies by utilizing and augmenting resources in all the Himalayan states from Jammu and Kashmir to Arunachal Pradesh. From the humble beginning, the DCFR is now emerging as the nodal facility in the country where research investigations are under taken both on capture and culture aspects with a focus on exotic and coldwater species. Since its inception, DCFR, in spite of limited scientific and technical manpower has made significant contribution for proper appraisal of coldwater fishery resources and evolve suitable technologies to propagate important fish species in hills.

The DCFR is on its glorious path of virtually actualizing its vision by imparting boon of quality research in sustainable coldwater fisheries production, management and conservation.

ANNEXURE-VII

The powers and duties of its officers and employees

Powers

DCFR is a Unit of the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). Director of this Directorate shall exercise such powers for their functioning as are delegated by the Governing Body or any authority of the ICAR. <u>Powers are delegated to the Director vide ICAR letter No. F. n(4)/75-Cdn (A&A) dated 01/04/1977</u> and modified vide <u>order No. 6-2/90-Cdn (A&A) dated 04/02/1993, 28/05/1994, 00 No. 6-3/92-Cdn (A&A) dated 28/07/1992.</u>

Duties of Director

- To plan/ coordinate research programmes and undertake case studies in the area of coldwater fisheries
- To coordinate the work of different units of this Directorate
- To provide consultancies to Universities/ Research institutes
- To carry out duties as may be assigned from time to time by any authority delegated power in this regard

Duties of Scientific Staff

- To guide, lead and contribute in training/research/consultancy in the areas of coldwater fisheries and its resources.
- To facilitate in bringing about inter-institutional linkages and collaboration.
- To carry out duties as may be assigned from time to time by the Director of this Institute or any authority delegated power in this regard.

ANNEXURE-VIII


