

Training-cum-input distribution programme organized by ICAR-CICFR, Bhimtal under SCSP

ICAR-Central Institute of Coldwater Fisheries Research (CICFR) organized three training-cum-input distribution programmes on “Fish seed stocking and feed management in carp culture” for carp farmers in mid hills of Nainital district under SCSP on 9th, 11th and 17th September 2025 at Bhimtal. The training was designed to enable farmer to learn stocking of proper sized quality seed, appropriate feeding, health care and management practices of carp farms in mid hills of Uttarakhand. Farmers also got opportunity to learn disease management in carp farming. CICFR has conducted frontline demonstrations on polytank based integrated polyculture of exotic carp with Good Management Practices (GMP) in various villages located in mid hills of Uttarakhand under SCSP.



At the end of the training programme, aquaculture inputs like carp feed, fish seed, hand nets, thermometers and anti-bird nets were distributed to farmers. It was coordinated by SCSP team under the guidance of Dr. Amit Pande, Director, ICAR-CICFR, Bhimtal.
